Who is BikeFest?

- BikeFest is a free event for the community, with a target of 10,000 visitors on the day
- It is hosted by:
 - The Tour Series 2022 organisers (Sweetspot) and their commercial partners
 - LBBD and Be First working in partnership, the official host and promoter
 - A huge range of community and voluntary groups – ranging from the Barking and Dagenham Cycling Club to the Barking heritage volunteers
 - Your organisation or business





The Green Village

- Entertainment centre integrated with race operations on Abbey Green
- Free to the public with marshalled access across the race track
 - Main stage with medal presentations and entertainment
 - Community stalls on green theme
 - Inclusive cycling promotion and advice, Dr Bike etc.
 - Commercial partners' marquees and pavilion (VIP networking centre)
 - Women's museum and heritage volunteers
 - Concessions and catering
 - Professional stewarding and marshalling
- Iconic Barking backdrop (Curfew Tower, St Margaret's Church)

The Tour series 2022

- 4.30- 8.30pm around Abbey Green
- The only London round
- First UK event to give equal billing to the women's race
- Men's race 5.30pm
- Women's Race 7.30pm
- Medal presentations and jerseys follow
- Coordinated and managed by Sweetspot





Electric Avenue

- Free to the public EV showcase in front of the Town Hall 20 and 21 May
- Showcase electric vehicles
 - Local dealers and leasing companies
- Consult on EV charging options
- Displays of e-bikes and scooters



BikeFest Community Racing

- 11am-4.30pm around Abbey Green race track
- Range of community events on the race course including, for example:
 - Inter-schools competition or events (British Cycling Go Ride) or youth races
 - Amateur races (invite by BDCC)
 - Corporate races (sponsors race)
 - E-bike race
 - Relay events
- Trophies and participants

Activating the Community

 - Barking & Dagenham Cycling Club
 - Abbey Green and neighbours St Margaret's, two schools, ASDA, leisure centre etc.
 - Local schools exhibitors, competitors, cheer stations
 - Outreach to other schools with mascots and a 'design the start flag schools competition
 - Green groups exhibitors
 - Gascoigne showcase and other neighbourhoods – exhibition activity
 - Local preparatory activity and heats
- Volunteer stewarding and marshalling
