# Second Annual TPFR Fall Kick-Off Meetup Fishing on the Gunpowder

When: Sunday September 25, 2022 Where: Gunpowder Falls - Masemore Rd access point 8am-ish until whenever

### Yup - It is time for the 2nd annual Gunpowder Fishing Day !!

Gunpowder Falls is a tailwater fishery of the Prettyboy Reservoir just north of Baltimore with 10 miles of fishable water. The river is a restoration success story and sustains a wild trout population with approximately 2,500 trout per mile - that equates to missing 1 trout every step. Access and wading is easy. #### So what is the Plan?

The TPFR Gunpowder Fishing Day will be free form. Bring you own rod, waders, flies, and food. But don't forget your aspirational net.

If you arrive before 10 am, some of other usual suspects from Casting Church and local stores will be on hand and hopefully we can help while on the water ... Aside from that, the plan is simple - show up, meet folks, chew the fat, go fish, and relax amidst the beautiful resources of the Gunpowder.

The Masemore Road is probably the easiest access on the river, and the start of the Lefty Krey Fishing Trail with plenty of holding places close to the parking. The river holds mostly browns, but you may meet Mr Bow, and if really lucky - Mr Brookie. The water may be warm enough to wet wade but plan on using your your waders. Finding a spot to fish dries, streamers, or a team of nymphs will be easy.

For family members or friends that don't fish, the Park has nice hiking trails that follow the river. Due to Park restrictions, we won't have access to picnic tables or a reserved space, and alcohol is prohibited.

This gathering will follow the same guidelines for health and safety that we use for the Casting Churches and Beer Ties. Relative to COVID-19, please adhere to national and State guidelines. Use your best judgment for the safety of you and others, if you are ill or suspect you might be, please respect the health of others and rest up at home.

#### **Directions to Masemore Rd Access:**

The Masemore Rd access point is 50 feet from the river. See directions and map.


- 1. From the DC area head up to the Baltimore loop (695) and either:
  - a. follow it through the 895 tunnel through Baltimore if you're ok with a toll, OR
  - b. follow 695 as it bends west to Towson and take the northbound exit for I-83.
    (Depending on traffic, take I-95, BW Pkwy, 29, or any other convenient route north and check the maps to *ultimately connect with I-83 northbound above Baltimore*.)
- 2. Take 83 north to the Mt Carmel Rd exit in Hereford.
- 3. Turn left from the exit onto Mt Carmel Rd, heading west.
- 4. Continue about 1/2 mile to Masemore Road (no stop sign or light) and turn right, heading north.
- 5. Continue about 3/4 mile along the 2 lane road.
- 6. Just before the parking, the road goes downhill with a very sharp hairpin curve around an old brick house (GO SLOW and BE CAREFUL)
- 7. Once past the curve, you will see the river and parking area on the right. The water is 75 ft away.

#### Parking:

- Use the gravel lot at the water. There are also few roadside places just before and after crossing the iron bridge.
- Room for about 15 18 cars.

Bathroom Facilities: Use Exxon or Royal Farms gas stations at the Mt Carmel Rd exit.
