## Four Mile Run Water Access Point

The Four Mile Run Conservatory Foundation has started a project to install an ADA-compliant water access point -- a floating launch for kayaks, canoes, and other non-motorized watercraft, at Four Mile Run. We are pleased to have the support of Alexandria's Department of Recreation, Parks, and Cultural Activities, which has committed \$16,000 in matching funds toward the first phase of this project: the engineering and design.



Siting a water access point at lower Four Mile Run presents the unique engineering challenge of designing a dock within a flood control channel, though it also affords an amazing opportunity for paddling access, fishing, and observing nature. Be part of the transformation of Four Mile Run to a vital recreational gateway to nature in an urban setting.
