6:45-7:20: Updates to Transportation System Development Charges (Anne Hill and Rich Eisenhauer, PBOT) *PBOT is updating its Transportation System Development Charge (TSDC) program. This includes updating the list of projects eligible for TSDC funding, refining the methodology for calculating TSDC charges, and reevaluating the rates that developers pay. Anne and Rich will brief the PAC on the updated methodology for calculating fees (which shifts from a focus on vehicle level of service to "person trips" to better capture all modes). They will also solicit feedback from the PAC on the proposed project list. The LTIC is intended to fund improvements on local residential streets that are unpaved and/or missing sidewalks, replacing the practice of accepting "waivers" for frontage improvements on residential streets.
