The project will provide sidewalks and bicycle facilities between SW Garden Home Rd. and SW Taylors Ferry. Steve will solicit feedback from the PAC on the designs, including the interaction of people walking, biking and waiting for transit on the proposed facilities.

7:15-8:00: PedPDX Vision, Goals, and Objectives (Francesca Patricolo, PedPDX Deputy Project Manager) The PedPDX Citywide Pedestrian Plan vision, goals, and objectives will guide all subsequent content of the Plan. Specifically, they will provide a critical foundation for the Plan's pedestrian network needs analysis, prioritization criteria, implementing strategies and actions (the "toolbox"), and performance measures.
