Regional Flexible Funds Allocation: policy update Every three years, Metro conducts a process to select projects for the Regional Flexible Funds. The RFFA is one of the few sources of funding available for active transportation projects. Over the past 10 months, discussions have been taking place to consider changes to existing policy. Primary among these proposed changes would be an elimination of policy that directs funding specifically to AT projects. If the proposed change is implemented, AT projects would still be a focus of the Flexible Funds, but there would be less certainty regarding how much of the funds would go to AT investments. A public comment opportunity on the RFFA begins in January and the BAC may wish to consider providing input to the process.
