

Firework Safety Tips for the 4th of July



Ensure your Independence Day weekend is filled with celebration and not regret with these fire safety tips:

- 1. Be sure fireworks are legal in your area before using or buying them.
- 2. Never use illegal fireworks
- 3. Always have an adult supervise fireworks activities and never allow children to play with or ignite fireworks.
- 4. Never hold lighted fireworks in your hands
- 5. Never light them indoors
- 6. Never point or throw fireworks at another person
- 7. Never ignite fireworks in a container, especially one that is glass or metal.
- 8. If you set off fireworks, keep a bucket of water handy in case of malfunction or fire.
- If fireworks malfunction, don't relight them! Douse and soak them with water then throw them away.
- 10. Sparklers Are Dangerous.
 - Every year, young children can be found along parade routes and at festivals with sparklers in hand, but sparklers are a lot more dangerous than most people think.
 - Sparklers burn at about 2,000 degrees hot enough to melt some metals.
 - Sparklers can quickly ignite clothing, and children have received severe burns from dropping sparklers on their feet.
 - According to the National Fire Protection Association, sparklers alone account for more than 25% of emergency room visits for fireworks injuries.
 - Consider using safer alternatives, such as glow sticks, confetti poppers or colored streamers. Sparklers alone account for one quarter of emergency room fireworks injuries.
