

Academic profile:

Credits: Successful participants will earn 5 ECTS credit points (CP). These credits can serve as substitutes in other institutions as well. Conversion of the credits by the student's home institution is in the hands of said institution and the student is responsible for making such arrangements. HMKW will gladly help with documents and clarifications in these situations.

Entry requirements:

Applicants...

- should be first or second year undergraduate students of Journalism, Politics, Philosophy, Communication, Liberal Arts or related fields.
- need to demonstrate a genuine interest in journalism.
- should be proficient in English (C1 level or above).
- must be at least 18 years old.

For your application, please attach your CV and an essay of motivation (with a minumum of 2,500 characters). Also prepare a compilation of materials on a journalistic topic of your choice. You won't have to submit the compilation with your application, but you will be expected to bring it along for the start of the summer school.
